### ***Duties:***

- i. *It shall be the duty of the Education and Research Committee to stimulate, promote, and evaluate prosthodontic research and determine areas where more research is needed.*

Evaluation of such education proposals must adhere to the ICP approved guidelines for such activities.*
- v. *The Education and Research Committee may also recommend or develop, with the approval of the Board, continuing education activities to be presented by the College for non-members or for other organizations or institutions.*

- vi. *It shall be the duty of the Education and Research Committee to conjointly with Ivoclar/Vivadent assess applications and select the winner of the Ivoclar Vivadent/International College of Prosthodontists Research Fellowship in Dental Restorative Materials*
- vii. *It shall be the duty of the Education and Research Committee to assess applications for and make a recommendation to the ICP Board for the awarding of the general Research Grants Program*
- viii. *It shall be the duty of the Education and Research Committee to assess and judge all poster presentations submitted for display at each Biennial meeting.*
